Maria Albin is professor of Occupational and Environmental Medicine at Karolinska Institutet, Stockholm, Sweden. She participates in the Horizon2020 Exposome Project for Health and Occupational Research EPHOR, and is PI for the research programme 'A sustainable new working life - exposure, health effects and governance'. She initiated the Swedish advocacy platform for Sustainable work in Horizon 2020, and has served as an expert to e.g., the Swedish commission on social inequalities in health, and the Swedish Work Environment Authority. Dr. Mary Trainor is Head of Science Impact and Quality at the UK Health and Safety Executive (HSE). She is an active member, and former chair, of the PEROSH Scientific Steering Committee. She began her career as an experimental particle physicist and was a Fellow at CERN in Geneva. She joined HSE's laboratory thirty years ago: she was Head of Risk Assessment, specialising in bringing together interdisciplinary scientific teams to provide solution-oriented research and support, and became the laboratory's Head of Science.
